BYLAW NO 02-2015

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF SMEATON TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES WITHIN A PORTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY

Section 8(1)(i) and Section 42 of *The Municipalities Act*

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Torch River No.488 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Short Title:

1. This bylaw may be referred as the “Smeaton Fire Protection Bylaw”

Purpose:

2. The purpose of this bylaw is to provide for entering into an agreement and to set procedures for the Fire Protection within a portion of the Rural Municipality of Torch River No. 488.

Intent:

3. The Rural Municipality of Torch River is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Village of Smeaton for Fire Protection Services.
4. The fire protection area shall be: Portion of Division 3 and 6 including the ‘Shipman trail Road’ into the Fort a la Corne Provincial Forest and Shore Gold and FLC sites within the Forest, and not including; from the Fort a la Corne Provincial Forest boundary to the Northern Provincial Forest between the east ½ of sections 14,23,26 & 35 of 51-19 W2, east ½ of sections 2,11,14,23,26 & 35 of 52-19 W2, East ½ of sections 2,11,14,23,26 & 35 of 53-19 W2.
5. The terms of the Agreement shall be set out in Exhibit “A”

Previous Bylaw:

6. Bylaw 02-2010 is now hereby repealed.
