

BYLAW 7-2007

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF TORCH RIVER NO. 488 TO LICENSE THE DRILLING OF OIL AND GAS WELLS AND MINING CONTRACTORS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Torch River No. 488 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this Bylaw:
"Contractor" shall include any person, firm or corporation; and
"Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Torch River No. 488
2. Any contractor under taking well-drilling in the municipality shall pay to the municipality the following license fee:
 - a) for the drilling of an oil well or a gas well \$450.00
 - b) for the drilling of a hold, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information \$225.00
3. Every mining contractor who is not assessable for the purpose of a business tax in the Municipality and who is in the operation of a mining business:
 - a) contracts to move earth, gravel, stones or mineral of any kind within the municipality; or
 - b) operates or offers for hire any machine, trailer, truck or appliance used in the process of drilling or of moving earth, gravel, stones, or minerals of any kind within the municipality; shall before undertaking such mining in the municipality pay to the municipality the license fee prescribed
4. Any contractor holding a license under this bylaw shall produce and exhibit his license when required to do so by the license inspector, police officer or other authorized person.
5. Any contractor found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalty provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
6. That this Bylaw shall come into effect on the date of final passing thereof.
7. Bylaw 9 – 1990 shall be repealed.
