


A BYLAW TO LICENSE AND REGULATE THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS.

The council of The Rural Municipality of Torch River No. 488 of the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Every person who owns, possesses or harbours a dog (which term shall, for the purpose of this bylaw, be deemed to mean either a male or female over two months old) within the Hamlet of Garrick shall obtain a license from the secretary-treasurer, and shall pay in advance the sum of \$5.00 for each male and spayed female dog and a sum of \$8.00 for each unspayed female dog.
2. All licenses issued under the provisions of this bylaw shall expire on December 31st next following the date of issue.
3. Any person residing in the Hamlet of Garrick who owns, possesses or harbours a dog and neglects or refuses to take out a license therefore shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this bylaw.
4. Every person to whom a license has been issued under this bylaw shall cause his dog to wear a collar to which shall be attached the license tag issued by this municipality.
5. No dog shall be allowed to run at large in the Hamlet of Garrick, and for the purpose of this bylaw, a dog shall be deemed to be running at large when it is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner, possessor or harbourer of the said dog, or beyond the boundaries of any lands where it may be with the permission of the owner or occupant of the said land and when it is not under control by being;
 - (a) in direct and continuous charge of a person competent to control it; or
 - (b) securely confined within an enclosure; or
 - (c) Securely fastened so that it cannot roam at will.
6. Any dog found running at large contrary to the provisions of this bylaw, whether licensed or not, may be killed by, or by Order of the municipal constable.
7. No vicious dog shall be allowed to run at large at any time, and such a dog may be killed by the municipal constable.
8. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provision of this bylaw, is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100.00.
