


BYLAW NO.4-1984


A BYLAW TO EXTEND THE PERMITTED USE OF PLASTIC PLUMBING MATERIALS

Under the provisions of Section 83 of the Public Health Act, R.R.S. 1978, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Torch River No. 488, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Saskatchewan Plumbing and Drainage Regulations, 1978 enacted under the Public Health Act the Garrick Community Centre of Garrick, Saskatchewan is hereby authorized to use plastic pipe and fittings in the plumbing system serving the structure known as Garrick Community Centre, located on Lots 9 & 10 Block 1 Hamlet of Garrick, Plan No. B0 2269.
2. The construction of such plumbing system shall be limited to use on one side of vertical fire separations and shall not be used within any vertical fire separations nor in a system where pipe passes through a horizontally aligned fire separation and shall be subject to and meet all requirements that may be imposed by:
 - a. the office of the Provincial Fire Commissioner, and
 - b. all other provisions of the Saskatchewan Plumbing and Drainage Regulations, 1978.
3. This bylaw shall come into force and effect upon approval of the Minister of Health.
