

BYLAW NO. 7 - 1981

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF TORCH RIVER NO. 488 TO
REGULATE PLUMBING AND DRAINAGE.

The council of the Rural Municipality of Torch River No. 488 in the
Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Plumbing and drainage piping in the Torch Trail Bible Camp dining
hall located on Pt. NW 34-51-18-W2nd meridian can be ABS or PVC
DWV plastic, providing that such pipe does not penetrate a fire
wall or a fire separation.

This bylaw shall come into force on the day of its approval by the
Department of Health.

Read a second time this 13th day of October, A.D. 1981. - Carried.



"Carried Unanimously".




