

BYLAW NO. 8-1984A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN
THE HAMLET OF GARRICK

The council of the Rural Municipality of Torch River No. 488
in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "curb" shall mean the lateral boundaries of a highway, whether or not marked by curbing;
 - (b) "highway" means any public highway within the municipality under the direction, control and management of the municipality and "public highway" means a public highway as defined by The Highways Act;
 - (c) "motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined by or pursuant to The Vehicles Act;
 - (d) "parking" shall mean the standing of a motor vehicle, whether occupied or not, upon a highway, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading, or in obedience to traffic regulations, traffic signs or signals, or the direction of a traffic officer or constable.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle under his control to be parked on Main Street and Railway Avenue within the Hamlet of Garrick, except as may be authorized by this bylaw.
3. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle under his control to stand unattended on Railway Avenue and Main Street within the Hamlet of Garrick, unless such motor vehicle shall first have been parked in the manner as provided in this bylaw.
4. Subject to the provisions of Sections 5 and 6 hereof the parking of motor vehicles is hereby permitted on all highways.
5. Vehicles parking on any portion of the north side of Railway Avenue from the intersection of Railway Avenue and Main Street to the intersection of Railway Avenue and First Street West, and on both sides of Main Street from the intersection of Railway Avenue and Main Street to the intersection of Main Street and First Avenue, must draw up to the curb on the right hand side of the highway at an angle of approximately forty-five degrees with the right front wheel at a distance of not more than thirty centimetres from the curb. Every area where angle parking is required shall be designated by the erection and maintenance of suitable signs or markers, clearly visible from the travelled portion of the highway showing that angle parking is required.


- 6. Vehicles are prohibited from parking at any time on the south side of Railway Avenue from the intersection of Railway Avenue and First Street West to the intersection of Railway Avenue and Main Street. Every area where parking is so prohibited shall be designated by the erection and maintenance therein of suitable signs or markers, clearly visible from the travelled portion of the highway showing that parking in such area is prohibited.
- 7. No person shall deface, injure, destroy or remove any sign or marker erected in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.
- 8. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
- 9. Bylaw No. 7-1984 is hereby repealed.


