Volunteers have a vested interest in their community, they share the common goal of safe homes, safe community. They know who live in their area. The group decides if they wish to do vehicle/foot patrols or do information sharing via email, twitter, or telephone. Volunteers: Observe-Record-Report to their local detachment any unusual or suspicious activities in their surroundings. The RCMP will inform the Rural Crime Watch group when there is criminal activity in the area.

Volunteers will have to complete a security check with their local RCMP.

Becoming a member of Rural Crime Watch does not take up a lot of your time. Volunteers are another set of eyes and ears for your local police when they may not be in your area. Working together helps the police solve crime and prevent further crime. This makes our communities a safer place to live.
